Holiday Traditions From All Around The World

It's not all about Rudolph's red nose or cookies and milk out for Santa - there are lots of unique traditions and customs that people celebrate in their corner of the globe to make their holidays bright.

- **Christmas Boats In Greece**
 - In early December in Greece, it's tradition for boats to be highly decorated with holiday lights and trim. St. Nicholas is the patron saint of sailors - so that's likely why boat decorating is so popular in a country where watercraft have been vital for its culture and development.
- **Simbang Gabi In The Philippines**
 - A nine-day celebration - Simbang Gabi is a Christian-based tradition to observe a series of daily masses for the days leading up to Christmas Eve. Outside of the church, Simbang Gabi is also a festive time of year, with brightly decorated and colored lanterns along with live music and holiday foods.
- **Scandinavian Yule Goat & Julebukking**
 - Instead of Santa being pulled by reindeer, this tradition may be rooted in Norse mythology - with Thor's chariot being pulled along by two goats. Nowadays, Yule goats are commonly seen as Christmas ornaments, usually made of straw and red ribbon. Julebukking is like a mix of Christmas caroling and Halloween treat-or-treating -- where singers go door-to-door wearing masks or costumes, hoping to be rewarded with candy.
- **Junkanoo - Bahamas Street Festival And Parade**
 - Like Carnival, participants wear elaborate costumes and celebrate with dancing and music in the streets. Celebrated from the day after Christmas through New Years (and in the summer in some places), those who don't craft costumes and dance can watch along the parade route to enjoy the festivities. The party traditionally starts at 2 AM and continues well into the morning!
